

Our Precious Past: Sharing Responsibility for Our Archaeological Heritage



Taken from a session at the TAG conference in Lampeter in 2003, these five essays look again at the cliché of breaking down the barriers and sharing information and responsibility of our past with the wider, non-archaeological community. These authors argue that if archaeologists really intend to do these things, this calls for a re-definition of archaeology `as a set of practices that connects beliefs, practices, aims, intentions and values, to create a community of shared interests. These papers from the conference provided a platform for graduates to address more seasoned archaeologists and suggest the way forward. They include contributions from an Egyptological perspective (Phillipa Payne) , `Theme-Park archaeology (David Barrowclough) , the relationship between metal-detectorists and archaeologists (Mary Chester-Kadwell) , between conservation and archaeology (Andrew Shapland) , and between politics and archaeology seen here from a Palestinian stance (Najat El Hafi) .
