
Diarmait King Of Leinster

Just such a black picture has built up over the years of Diarmaits outrageous behaviour: stories of rape, abduction, mutilation and murder, of the fierce hatred he provoked in his enemies, and which ultimately led to his downfall. But behind this also lies the story of a cultured and accomplished ruler, a man who inspired love and loyalty in his family and absolute devotion from his followers, and who became so attracted to church reform that he established monasteries and abbeys for the Cistercians and Augustinians. This is the story of Diarmait, King of Leinster, one of the foremost kings of Ireland, and a key figure in Irish history. Nicholas Furlong is a journalist, historian and author from County Wexford.
