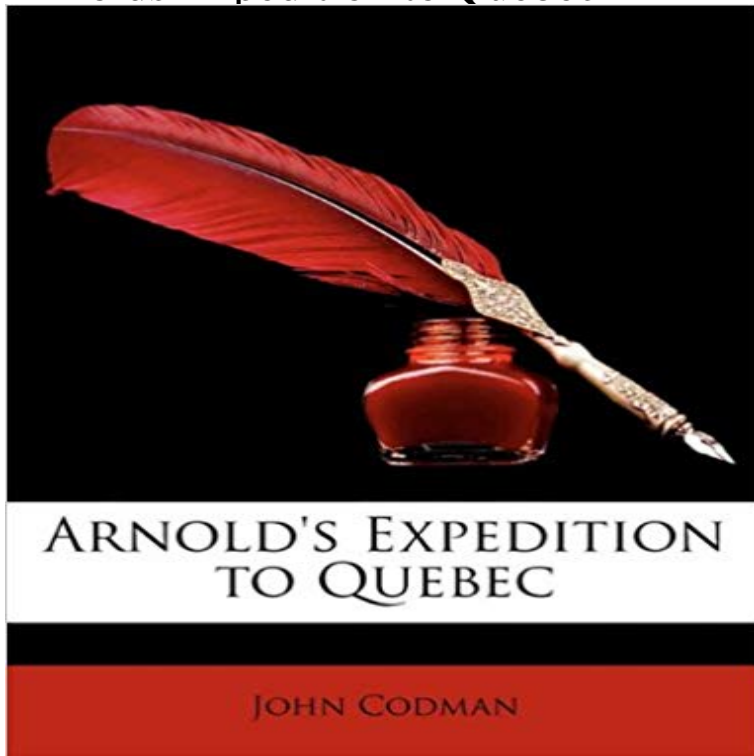


Arnolds Expedition to Quebec
