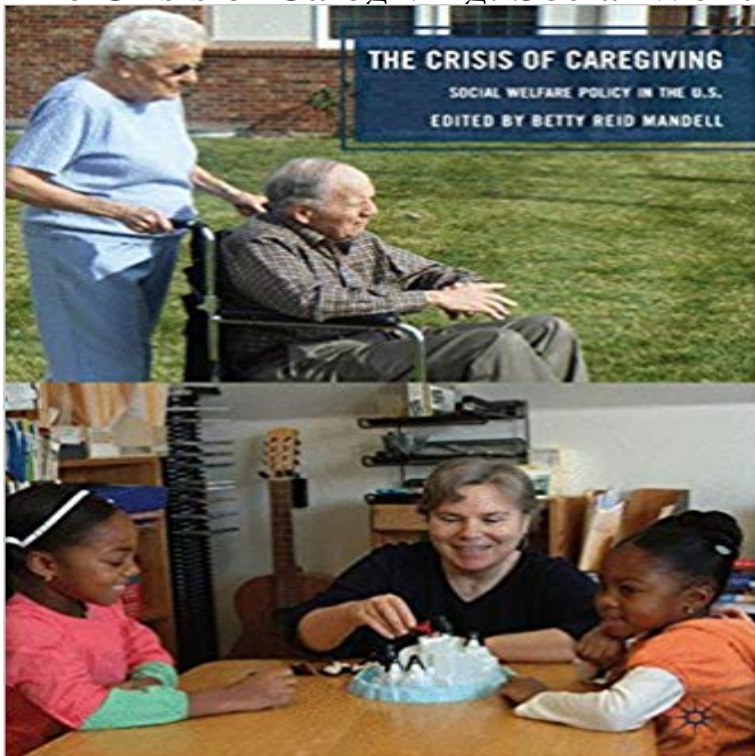


The Crisis of Caregiving: Social Welfare Policy in the United States
