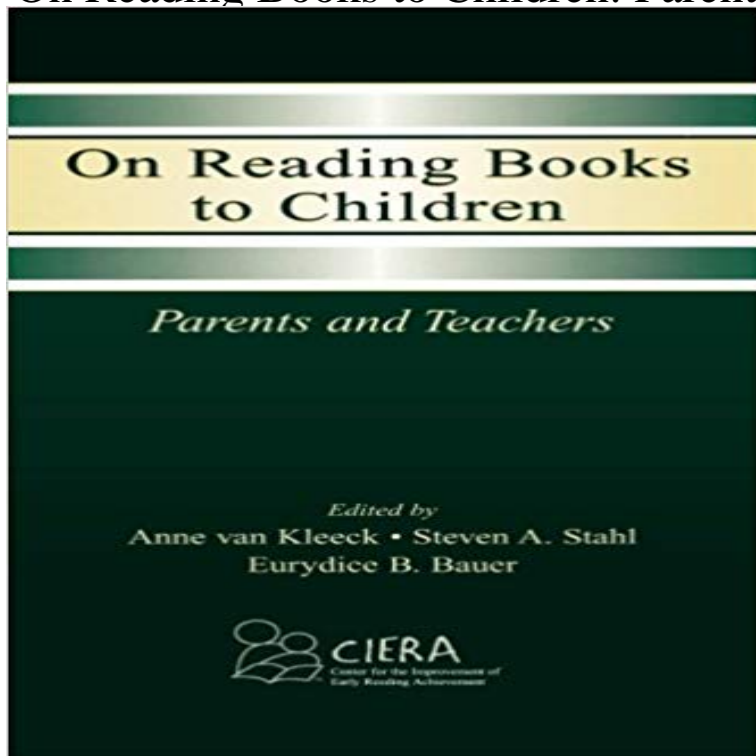


## On Reading Books to Children: Parents and Teachers
