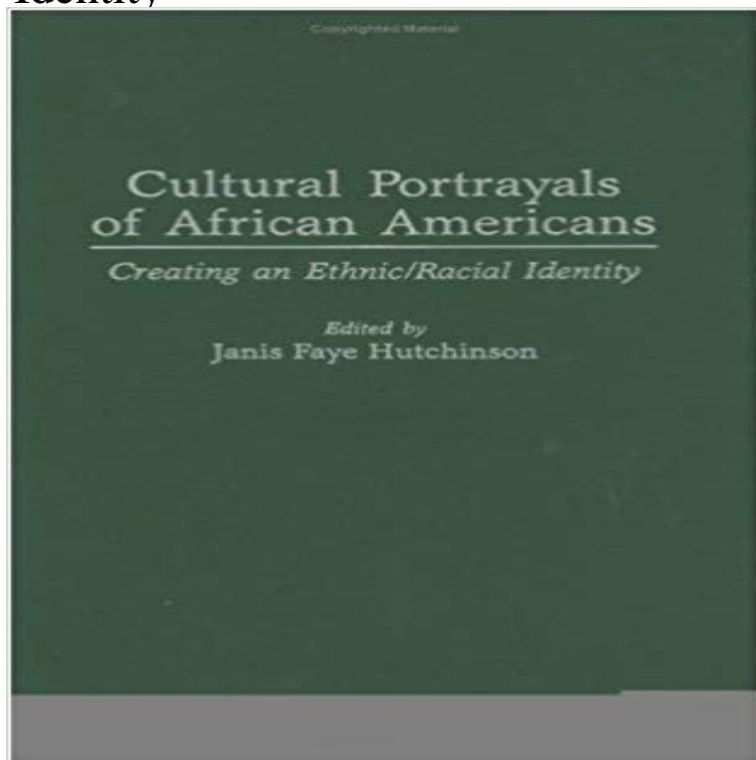


Cultural Portrayals of African Americans: Creating an Ethnic/Racial Identity
