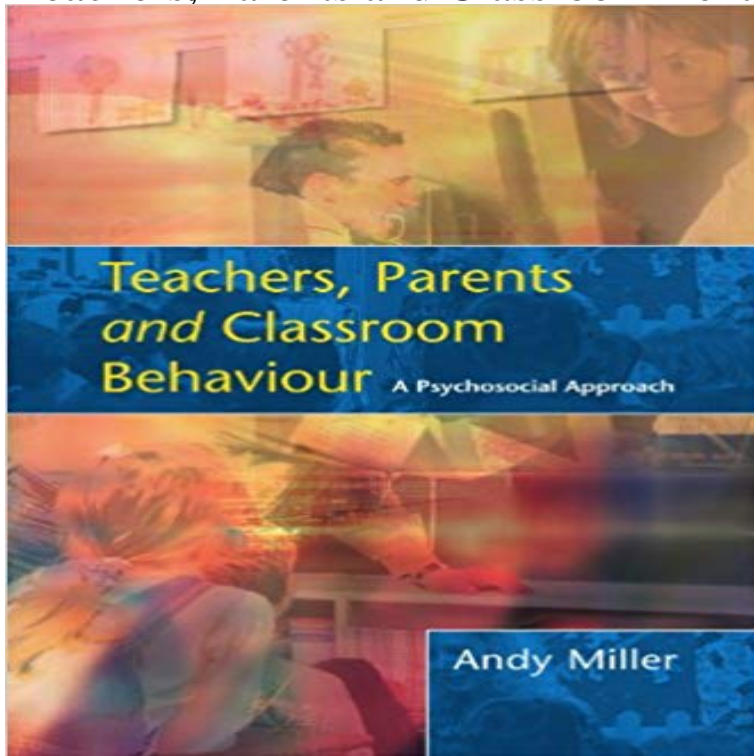


Teachers, Parents and Classroom Behaviour
