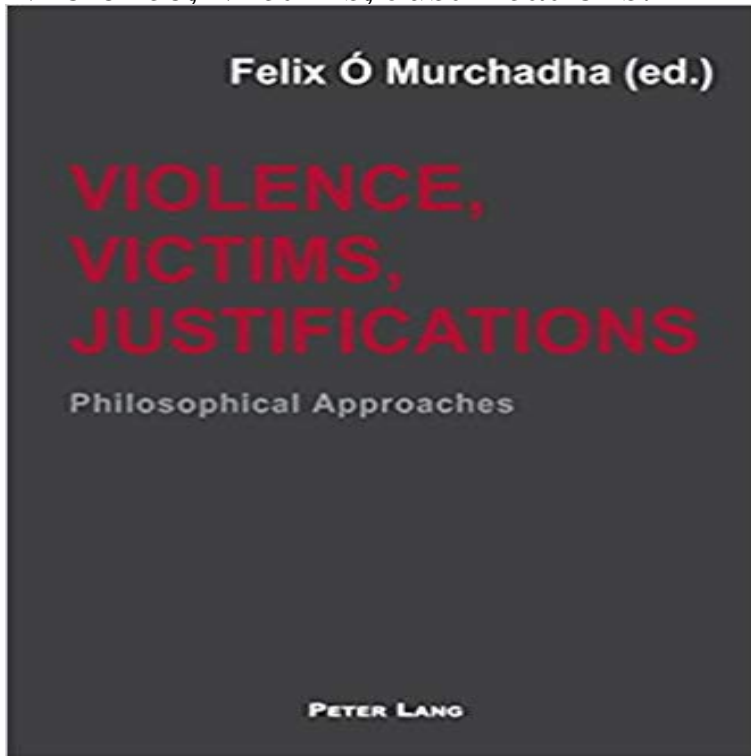


# Violence, Victims, Justifications: Philosophical Approaches
