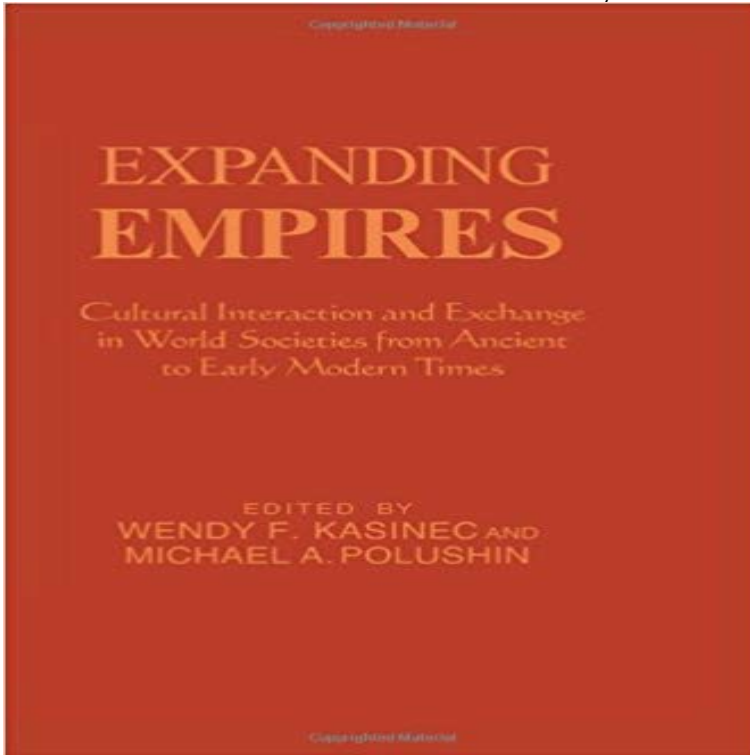


Expanding Empires: Cultural Interaction and Exchange in World Societies from Ancient to Early Modern Times (The World Beat Series)
