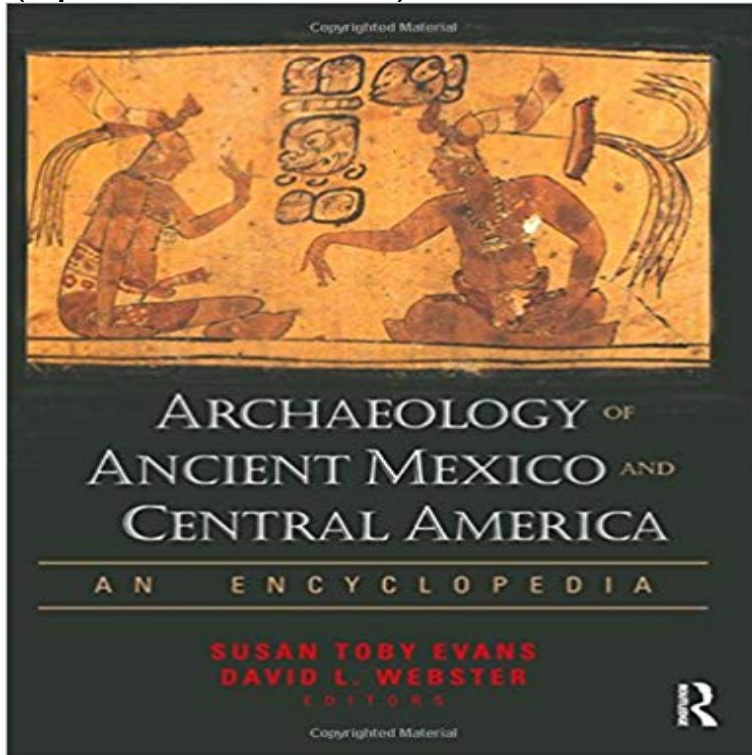


Archaeology of Ancient Mexico and Central America: An Encyclopedia (Special -Reference)
