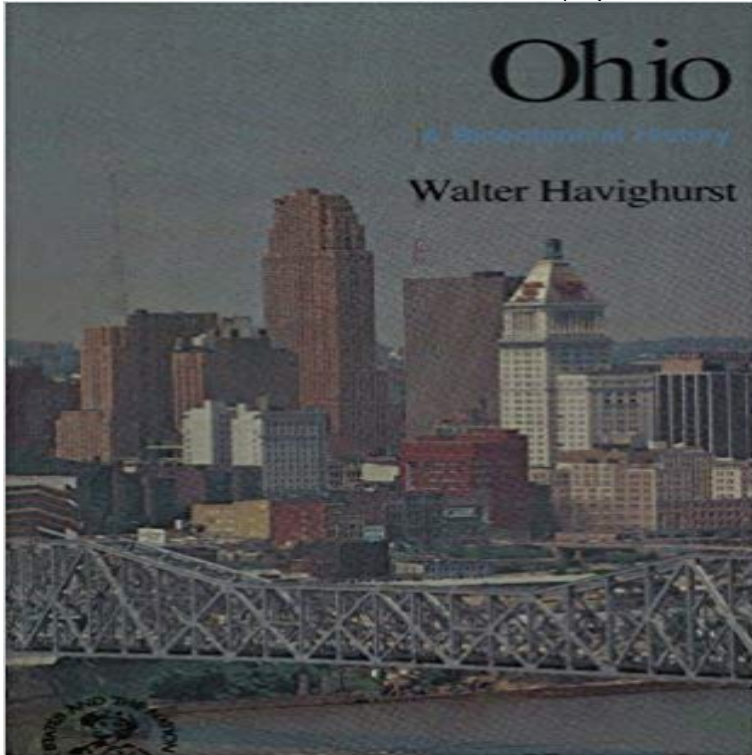


Ohio: A Bicentennial History (States and the Nation)
