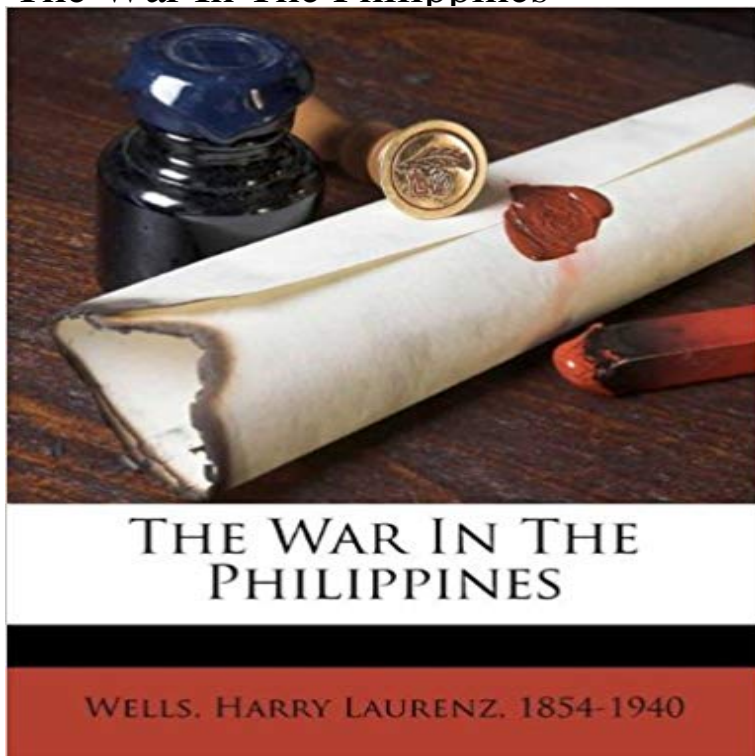


The War In The Philippines
