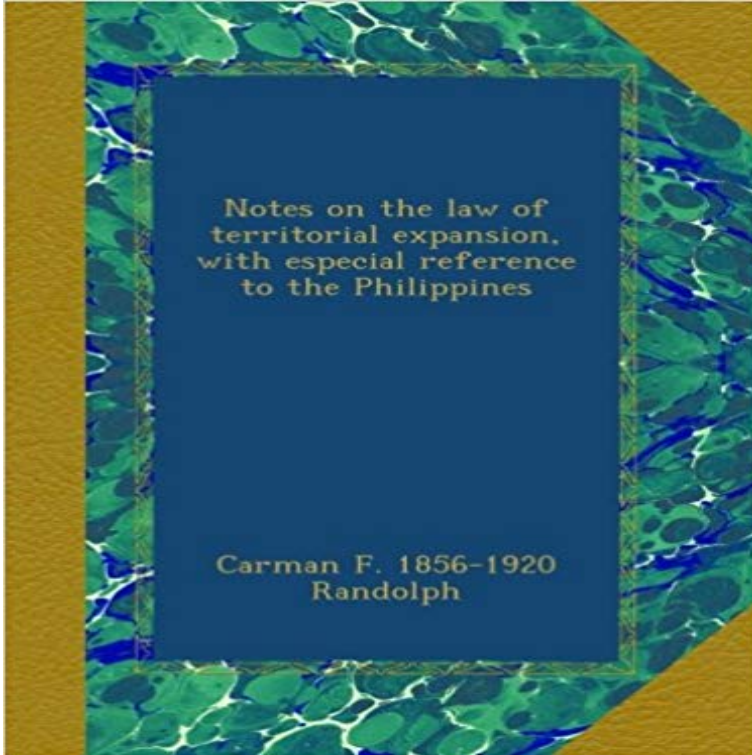


Notes on the law of territorial expansion, with especial reference to the Philippines
