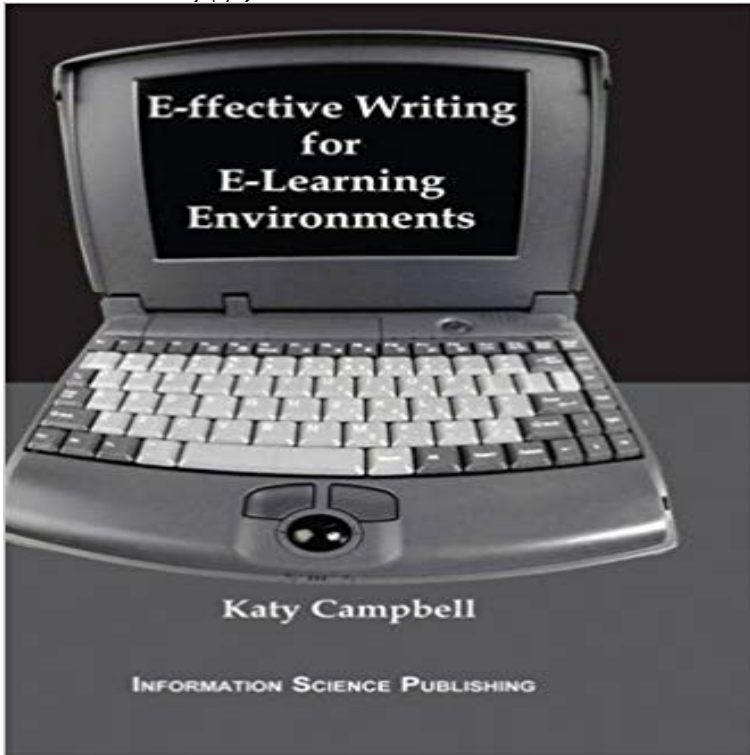


E-ffective Writing for E-Learning Environments (Cases on Information Technology)
