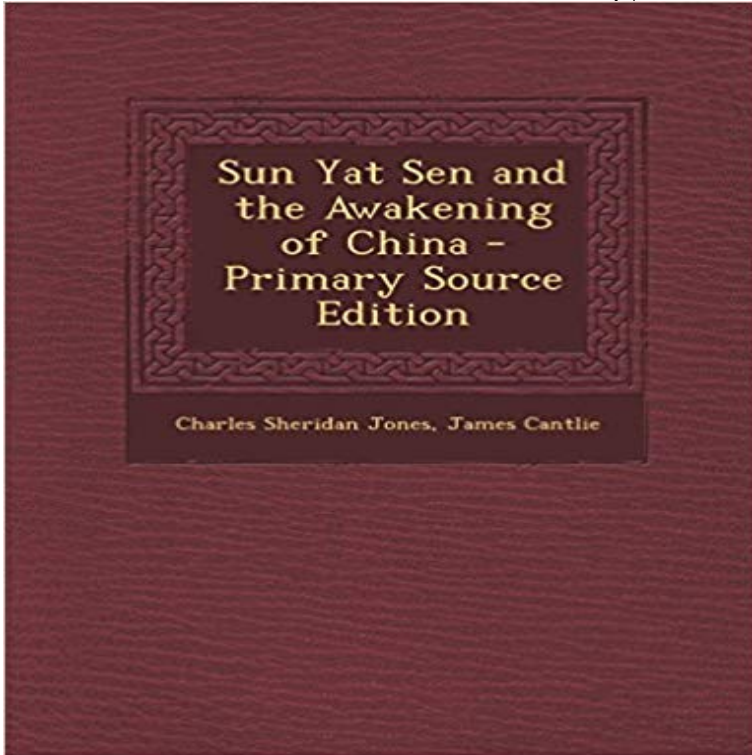


Sun Yat Sen and the Awakening of China - Primary Source Edition
