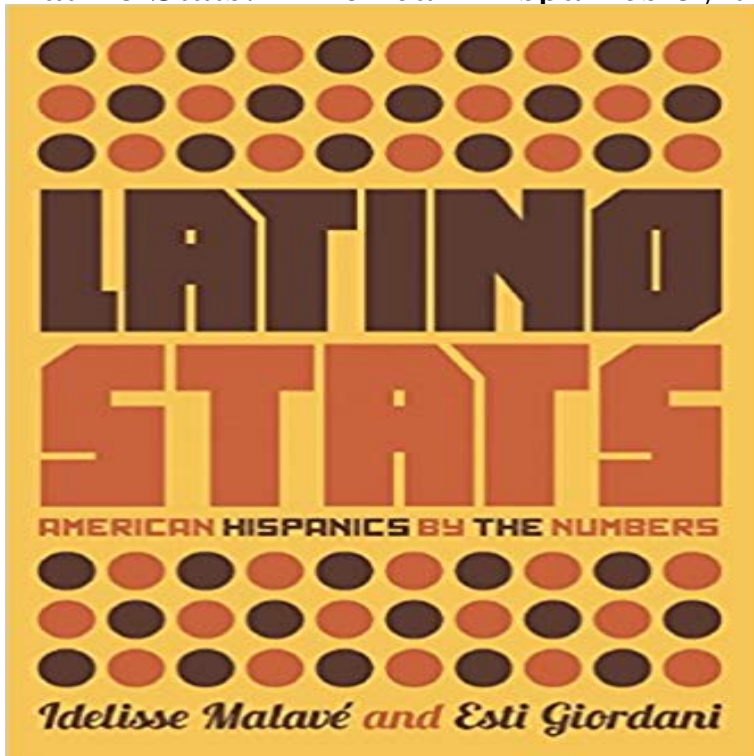


Latino Stats: American Hispanics by the Numbers
