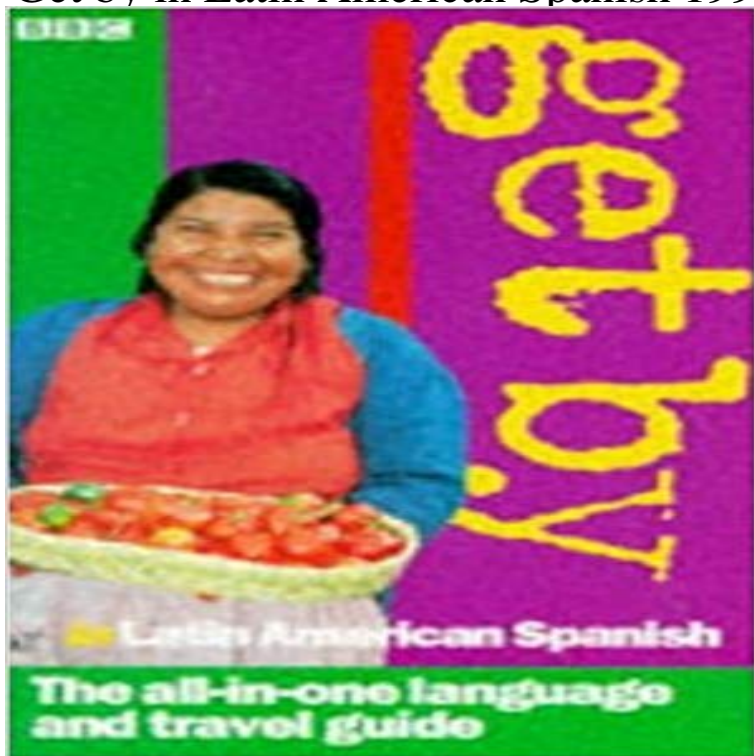


Get by in Latin American Spanish 1998: 1998 Book
