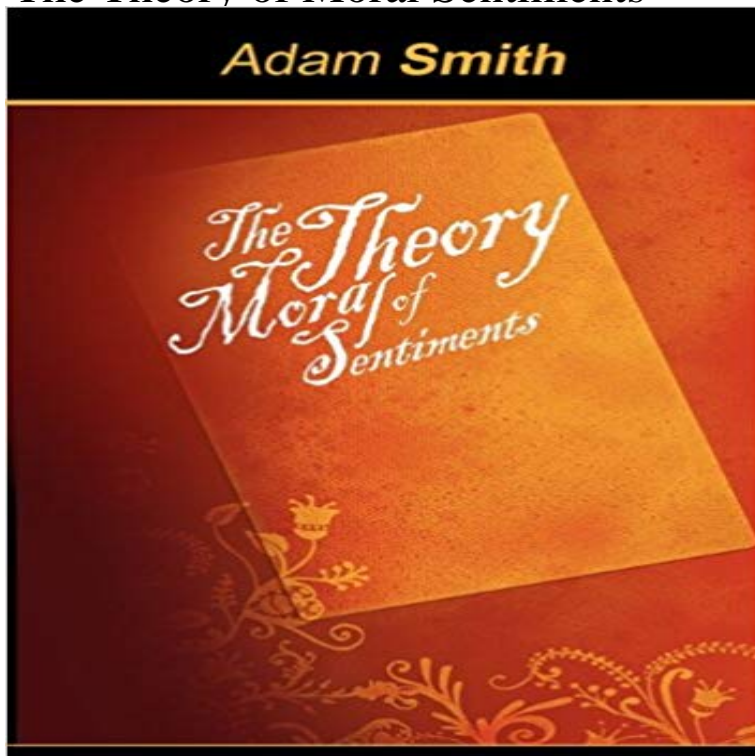


## The Theory of Moral Sentiments
