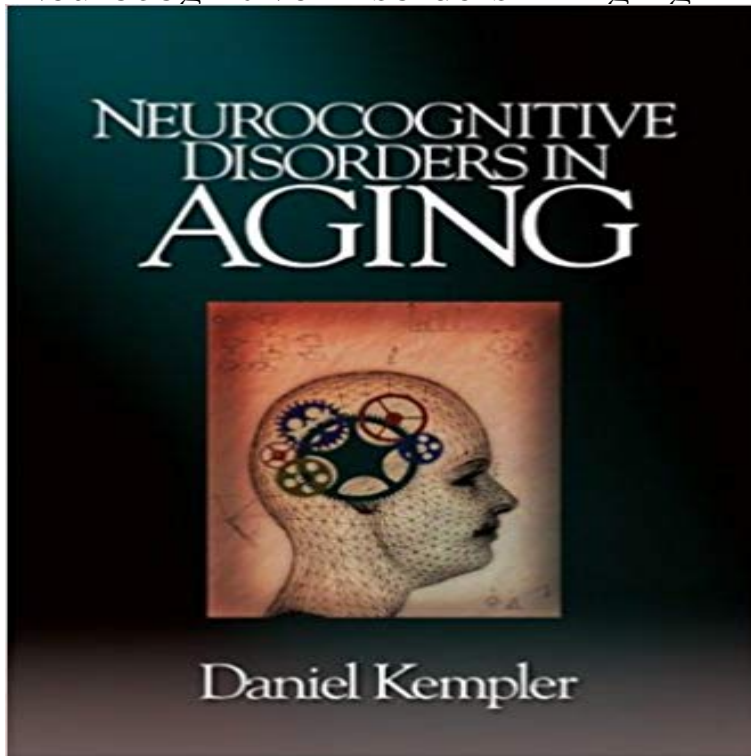


## Neurocognitive Disorders in Aging
